

RYLA Dress Code and Necessary Items

Clothes to wear

Arrival (Friday): Casual attire. Nice jeans and capris. Shorts must be no shorter than just above knee length. Pants must be worn on the waist. You will be asked to change whenever your attire is not appropriate. You will receive a blue T-shirt to wear Saturday.

Teen Court (Friday night): Business attire. NO jeans. NO flip flops. Khaki or dress pants, skirts, dresses, dress shirts or polos. You will not be able to participate if you are not dressed appropriately.

Workshops and Food Packing Project (Saturday): Casual attire. You will be given a blue RYLA T-shirt to wear today. You will be attending workshops provided by business professionals and should be presentable.

Evening Dinner/Dance (Saturday): Semi-formal such as homecoming attire. Boys – shirt and tie or suit. Girls – dress, suit, or skirt and blouse.

Wrap-up (Sunday): Casual attire.

You will be walking several blocks from the dormitory to the classrooms and the cafeteria, so bring comfortable walking shoes. Bring a rain jacket or umbrella.
